

what she cooks SWEDISH SOUL-FOOD AND BAKED GOODIES

SWEDE TREATS:

A GRAPHIC DESIGNER TURNS A CRAMPED,
OLD HDB KITCHEN INTO A SCANDINAVIAN HAVEN.

he was "sort of" soul-searching in Europe when local graphic designer Tasneem Noor met Swedish artist Joakim Hesham Smidhagen in 2006. A long-distance courtship and one year later, the young couple got married and set about creating a home in Singapore. The heart of the home, the kitchen, was "just finished this June", says Tasneem.

From the owner of their three-bedroom HDB flat –"my father" Tasneem reveals sheepishly – they inherited a grey-laminate kitchen with wood trim. Fortunately her father sprung for the kitchen reno, and Tasneem happily narrates, "let me design it my way." The redesign was inspired by images of all-white, country-style kitchens.

Budget constraints did not deter the

resourceful designer from achieving her dream kitchen. She retained some of the existing elements such as the fridge, flooring and oven, and engaged interior consultant The Cottage Crafts to install her mixed built-in cabinets and open shelving. She also scoured lkea, craft and second-hand shops for complementary accessories. The chimney-style cooker hood, for instance, which she bought from kitchen and bathroom fittings shop Sim Siang Choon, was a display unit and is no longer in stock. "We were lucky to have that last piece!" the intrepid shopper says.

Tasneem also changed the cramped kitchen configuration to a more efficient work triangle

(ie, store-prep-cook). Now there are separate food preparation spaces for both cooking and baking. Little knick-knacks like candles and inspiring images like a cartoon by Joakim add warmth and a touch of quirkiness. The result is a charming Scandinavian kitchen where her specialities – Swedish meatballs, roasts and baked pastas – fit right in.

Developing Swedish inclinations, from her design style to her cooking, came naturally to Tasneem after her marriage. "I've just fallen in love with everything Swede," she smiles. •
